3. Identifying the Parts

3.1 Wireless Party Speaker



- 1  Place your tablet and phone.
- 2 **Party Link button**
Press to enter Party Link pairing mode.
- 3 **TWS pair button**
 - Press to enter True Wireless Stereo (TWS) pairing mode.
 - It work only when you have two identical speakers.
- 4 **Mic 1 Vol+/- Knob**
Adjust microphone volume.
- 5 **Mic 2 Vol+/- Knob**
Adjust microphone volume.
- 6 **Echo +/- Knob**
Adjust the microphone echo level.
- 7 **Bass +/- Knob**
Adjust bass level.
- 8 **Vol +/- Knob**
Increase/Decrease the volume.
- 9 **Treble +/- Knob**
Adjust treble level.
- 10 **LED indicator**
- 11 **Bass Boost button**
 - Press to enhanced bass and volume.
 - Press and hold to skip the previous track in Bluetooth/USB mode.
- 12  **button**
 - Start, pause or resume play.
 - Press and hold to skip the next track in Bluetooth/USB mode.
- 13  **Bluetooth / pair button**
 - Switch to Bluetooth mode.
 - Press and hold to activate the pairing function in Bluetooth mode or disconnect the existing paired Bluetooth device.
- 14  **Light button**
Press to switch different light colors and mode.
- 15  **button**
 - Press and hold for 3 seconds to switch on/off the unit.
 - Press to check battery level in power on status.
- 16 **Speaker light**
- 17 **USB Socket**
- 18 **Mic 2 Socket**
- 19 **Audio in Socket**

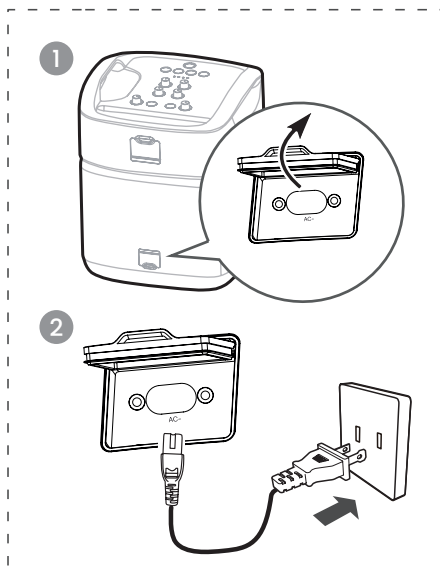

4. Connections

4.1 Connect to Power

Risk of product damage!

- Risk of product damage! Ensure that the power supply voltage corresponds to the voltage printed on the back or the underside of the party speaker.
- Before connecting the AC power cord, ensure you have completed all other connections.
- Connect the mains cable to the AC~ socket of the party speaker and then into a mains socket.



4.2 Use the Audio in/Audio out Socket

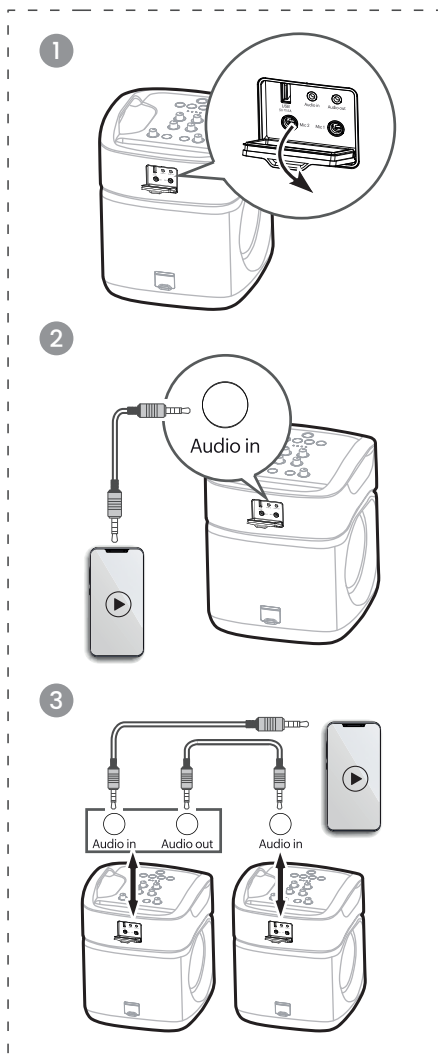
With this product, you can listen to an external audio device such as an MP3 player.

Play from an MP3 player

1. Connect an audio input cable (not supplied) with a 3.5mm connector on both ends to:
 - The **Audio in** socket on the unit.
 - The headphone socket on the MP3 player.
2. Play audio on the MP3 player (refer to its user manual).

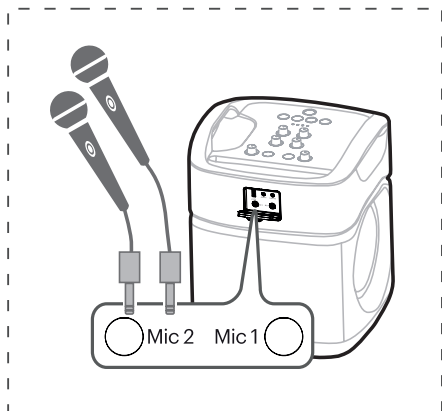
Audio out

- This unit has an Audio out socket. You can output the analog stereo audio signals to external devices such as an active speaker.
- Connect an audio cable (not supplied) to the Audio out socket on the unit and the audio in socket of the external device, and the unit will output audio automatically to the external device.




4.3 Use the Mic 1/Mic 2 Socket

Connect a microphone (not supplied) into the Mic 1 / Mic 2 socket of the party speaker.



5. Basic Operation

5.1 Turn On / Off

Press and hold the  button for 3 seconds to switch on/off the unit.

Tips:

- The speaker will turn off automatically after 15 minutes without user operations and music playback.
- Disconnect the mains plug from the mains socket if you want to switch the soundbar OFF completely.

5.2 Adjust the Volume

Rotate the Vol **+/-** Knob on the unit to increase or decrease the volume.

5.3 Adjust the Bass Level

Rotate the BASS **+/-** Knob on the unit to adjust bass level.



5.4 Adjust the Treble Level

Rotate the Treble **+/-** Knob on the unit to adjust treble level.

5.5 Adjust the Bass Boost

Press the Bass Boost button to switch on/off the Bass Boost.

5.6 Adjust the Brightness

1. Turn speaker light on or off.
 - In power on mode, press the  Light button repeatedly to switch among different light modes of speaker light.
2. Change brightness.
 - Press and hold the  Light button for 3 seconds to change speaker light brightness.

5.7 Adjust Microphone Volume



Connect a microphone (not supplied) into the Mic in socket of the unit, and adjust the microphone volume by turning the Mic 1/Mic 2 **+/-** knob.

5.8 Adjust Echo


Adjust the microphone echo level to your desired level by turning the Echo **+/-** Knob.

5.9 Demo Mode


Enter demo mode

In standby mode (Plug the AC power cord), press and hold the  and  button at the same time. The unit can be activated the demo sound.

Note:

1. If you want to listen the demo sound longer, you can press the  button to repeat the demo sound.
2. Rotate the Vol **+/-** Knob on the unit to increase or decrease the demo sound volume level.

Exit demo mode

Press and hold the  button for 3 seconds the unit will go to standby mode.

6. Bluetooth Operation

You can listen to tracks from a media device if connected to the unit via Bluetooth.


First time pairing



The first time you connect your bluetooth device to this player, you need to pair your device to this player.

Note:

- The operational range between this player and a Bluetooth device is approximately 8 meters (without any object between the Bluetooth device and the unit).
- Before you connect a Bluetooth device to this unit, ensure you know the device's capabilities.
- Compatibility with all Bluetooth devices is not guaranteed.
- Any obstacle between this unit and a Bluetooth device can reduce the operational range.
- If the signal strength is weak, your Bluetooth receiver may disconnect, but it will re-enter pairing mode automatically.

- 1 Press the  button to switch the Bluetooth mode.
- 2 On the Bluetooth device, switch on Bluetooth, search for and select "AP4040BT" to start connection.
- 3 Wait until you hear voice prompt from the party speaker.
- 4 Play music from the connected device.

Short press 	Start, pause or resume play
Long press Bass Boost	Previous track
Long press 	Next track

To disconnect the Bluetooth function:

- Switch to another source on the unit.
- Disable the function from your Bluetooth device.


- Press and hold the  button on the unit the LED indicator blinks blue.

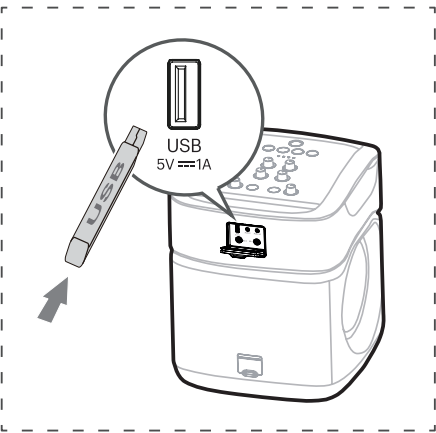
Tips:

- The player will also be disconnected when your device is moved beyond the operational range.
- If you want to reconnect your device to this player, place it within the operational range.
- If the device is moved beyond the operational range, when it is brought back, please check if the device is still connected to the player.
- If the connection is lost, follow the instructions above to pair your device to the player again.

7. USB Operation

By connecting a USB mass storage device (e.g. USB flash drive) to this speaker, you can enjoy the device's stored music through the speaker.

- To pause or resume play, press the  button on the speaker.



Tips:

- The unit can support USB devices with up to 64 GB of memory.
- This unit can play MP3.


8. TWS Operation

Two speakers can pair with each other for stereo sound.


Tips:

- TWS works only if there are two identical party speakers.

Select master speaker manually

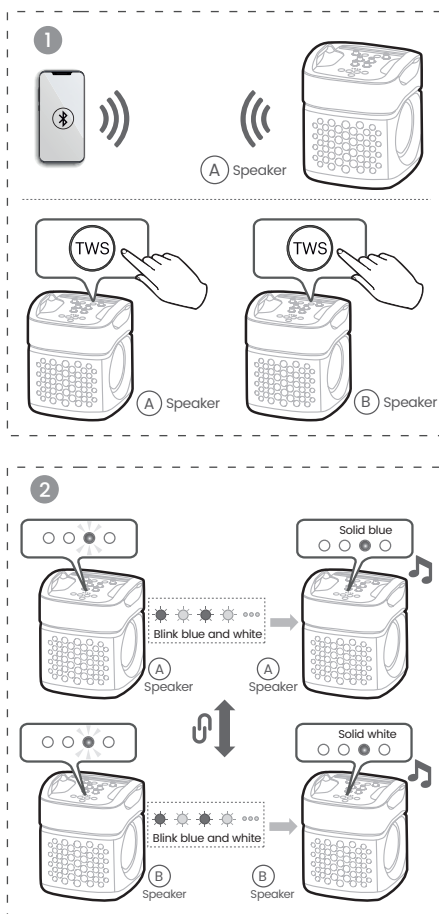
- Press and hold the  button for 3 seconds to power on both speakers and enter to Bluetooth pairing mode.
- Select one speaker as master and connect to Bluetooth.
- Press the TWS button on both speakers to enter stereo pairing mode (TWS).
- When TWS is connected, you will hear a voice prompt.
- To exit TWS, press and hold the TWS button on either speaker.

Select master speaker automatically

- Press and hold the  button for 3 seconds to power on both speakers.
- Press the TWS button on both speakers to enter stereo pairing mode.
- To exit TWS, press and hold the TWS button for 3 seconds on either speaker.

Note:


- During TWS pairing mode, both master and slave speaker will return to previous state automatically after 1 minute without user operations or TWS pairing is not successful.



9. Party Link Operation

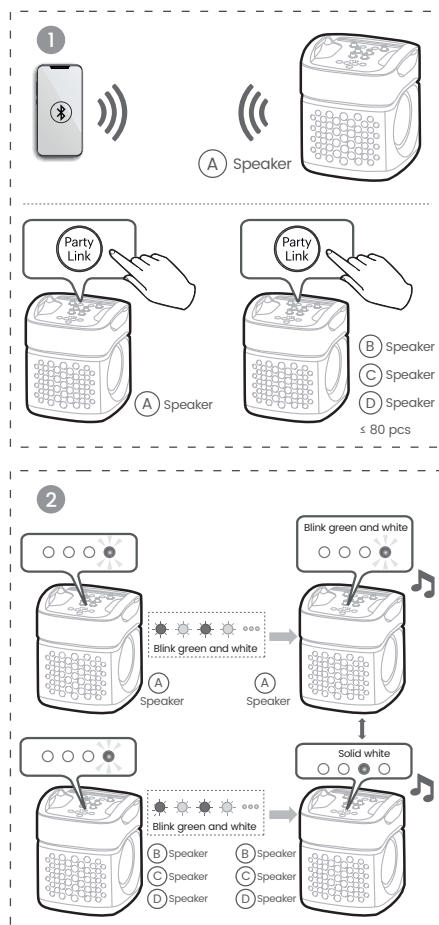
The speaker can connect up to 80 party speakers together and play audio at the same time.

Enter Party Link mode

- Press and hold the  button for 3 seconds to power on party speakers and enter to Bluetooth pairing mode.
- Select one speaker as master and connect to Bluetooth.
- Press the Party Link button on all speakers to enter Party Link pairing mode.
- When Party Link is connected, you will hear a voice prompt.
- Press and hold the Party Link button on master speaker. All speakers will exit Party Link mode.

Note:

- During Party Link pairing mode, slave speaker will return to previous state automatically after 1 minute without user operations or Party Link pairing is not successful.
- No timeout on master speaker.



10. Troubleshooting

To keep the warranty valid, never try to repair the system yourself. If you encounter problems when using this unit, check the following points before requesting service.

Problem	Solution
No power	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure that the unit is fully charged or connected with a power source.• Ensure that all the required cables are securely connected.• Ensure that the unit is switched on.• To save power, the unit switches to standby automatically 15 minutes after a play reaches the end and no control is operated.
No sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Adjust the volume.• Check the sound input source.
Cannot display some files in USB device	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The number of folders or files in the USB device has exceeded a certain limit. This phenomenon is not a malfunction.• The formats of these files are not supported.
USB device not supported	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The USB device is incompatible with the unit. Try another one.
The audio quality is poor after connection with a Bluetooth-enabled device.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The Bluetooth reception is poor. Move the device closer to this product or remove any obstacle between them.
